



## COLLEGE FEE SCHEDULE for GRADUATE Residents in 2017

The College is pleased to offer you a residential place for the academic year 2017.  
Please read this Fee Schedule in conjunction with your 2017 Graduate Residential Offer.

### 2017 FEES & CHARGES

The following fees will apply for residence in 2017:

- An enrolment deposit of \$575 for new students entering the College
- For continuing students, a re-enrolment deposit of \$575 which will be credited to your February fee account as a prepayment toward your February fees
- A graduate room condition deposit of \$600, refundable on departure from Ormond, satisfactory room condition and return of College property (i.e. keys, gown, library books etc.).
- There will in addition be charges for the annual Subscription to the MCR and for events in the Graduate Orientation program in February. The cost of the MCR subscription is still to be determined for 2017. (2016 - \$310 Inc. GST)
- Two options are being offered for meals. There is a Full Meal option which includes 3 meals a day, 7 days a week. There are also 7 meal or 14 meals per week options. You will be charged at the full fee rate and then a credit will be applied to your account should you choose a 7 or 14 meal plan. Any extra meals will then be charged at a rate of \$8 per meal.
- Late payment fees are charged at 12% per annum
- In 2017, Internet will cost \$130 (Inc. GST) per student per Semester. This cost will include unlimited internet usage.
- Please note food, accommodation and learning costs do vary between options. The basis of this is GST legislative requirements set by the ATO.

Please note that during non-teaching months, the College kitchen may not be open and substitute meal arrangements are not offered.
