



## Fee Schedule - Undergraduate Residents 2023

The 2023 Undergraduate fee includes accommodation in a furnished single study bedroom for 35 weeks of the academic calendar inclusive of mid-semester break periods, the provision of 3 meals 7 days each week and a brunch offering on Sundays.

College fees also include the learning programs, leadership programs, internet usage, information services, sports facilities, a fitness membership with Melbourne University Sport, and music practice studios. Each bedroom on the main campus has wireless access with wireless access provided in the Academic Centre, in the JCR Cafe, Common Rooms and other shared areas of the College. A comprehensive range of graphic, printing & photocopying resources are provided in the Academic Centre. Printing is charged on a user pay basis.
